Business@Mail is the service developed by EDICOM for the **fast and secure delivery of all types of electronic documents, including invoices, purchase orders, payrolls**, etc. The service includes a web environment accessible to recipients, where they can consult, download, or print the documents made available by one or multiple publishers.

Integrate Business@Mail with your management system to automate the creation and delivery of all your documents. Stop processing invoices, purchase orders and other transactions manually. Reduce costs and response times by delivering your documents immediately after generation.


The Business@Mail interface is designed to provide an optimal user experience. Publishers and subscribers can easily and intuitively search, preview and download, or take custom actions on documents.



HOW DOES BUSINESS@MAIL WORK?

Automate electronic document delivery to 100% of your customers

1. The publisher's ERP exports a data file in a format previously agreed upon with EDICOM to create the outgoing document.
2. The EDICOM platform transforms the ERP data into the required structured data format (XML, EDIFACT, X12, etc.).
3. EDICOM identifies the document's recipient and, when the recipient is not EDI capable, the document is published to Business@Mail in its electronic format, along with PDF version.
4. Business@Mail sends an e-mail notifying the recipient that a new document has been uploaded to the platform.
5. The recipient ("subscriber") accesses the Business@Mail service to view or download the document.
6. Documents are stored at no cost to the subscriber, allowing them constant access and sending receipt acknowledgements to the publisher.



TOTAL CONTROL OVER YOUR DOCUMENTS

Get receipt acknowledgements to monitor document status

Document publishers receive status notifications for every action their recipients perform on a document, even if none is taken. Business@Mail also allows you to check that the documents and their notifications are arriving properly.

The traceability afforded by Business@Mail makes it possible to proactively manage invoices based on the acknowledgements received, thus reducing response times, and speeding up payments.

100% Compliance

Business@Mail integrates EDICOM's electronic signature services and connectivity with tax administrations for e-invoicing compliance.
