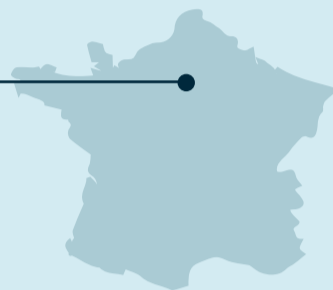

Rollout of the **NSO platform** for submission of purchase orders to **public healthcare sector suppliers.**

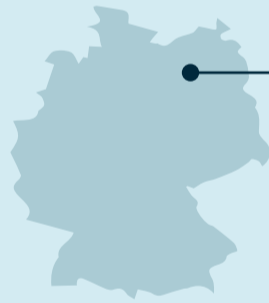

SWEDEN

! 01/04/2019

A draft law currently being revised by the Swedish authorities would oblige all **public entities to require electronic invoices as of April 1, 2019.** In consequence, all public bodies should be able to receive PEPPOL BIS invoices as of the same date.

NORWAY

08/2019 !

The Agency for Public Sector Management and e-Administration will launch a **new version of the EHF format for invoices and for credit notes 3.0.** The new standard will be based on the **PEPPOL BIS** specifications and is due for publication in August 2018.
